## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO REVIEW BEFORE COMPLETING REGISTRATION AND CONSENT FORM**

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This is a three-page form. Prior to completing the information on the second page, it is important for you to review this introduction.

Players who participate in LDATL are permitted to play baseball in other leagues. We hope that you consider our League as your baseball priority as much as possible.

Also, as a condition of registration, you will be required on page 3 to list any scheduling conflicts you may have during the LDATL season (which typically runs from the spring to the third or fourth week of July). Having an excessive amount of conflicts will not disqualify you from playing in LDATL, but it may affect when players are selected in the LDATL draft and by which team.

These rules are not intended to "turn off" players from participating in LDATL. We encourage players to play as much baseball as possible and understand there will be scheduling conflicts. These conditions of registration will help to ensure that players who do show up for the vast majority of games and practices are rewarded for their devotion and commitment to LDATL, their team and their teammates.

Only players who will be 13 years old before May 1 but not over 15 years old before that date are eligible to participate. No player who will be 16 before May 1 is eligible. A copy of each player’s birth certificate must be presented to league officials when signing up or when this form is returned.
